

A brief article on numerology and magic - Part 1

Hello, **dear readers**, how are you? Well, I hope you are well and very happy right now and as I promised you, I will start my little dossier on numerology, magic, kabbalah and maybe I will also talk a little bit about secret societies, as well as explaining the use of numbers for practitioners of magic. The content is quite extensive and complex since it involves talking about different topics, but I will try my best to explain to you how the use of numbers works.



This is the first part of an article on numerology in which I decided to write other parts talking about specific topics to avoid any mistakes and confusion. In this introductory part, I will only talk about the meaning of each number and some applications.

God created the world by following mathematical precepts, so I must also point out that the numbers themselves are not bad, but their selfish practice and use makes the numerology practitioner a bad person.

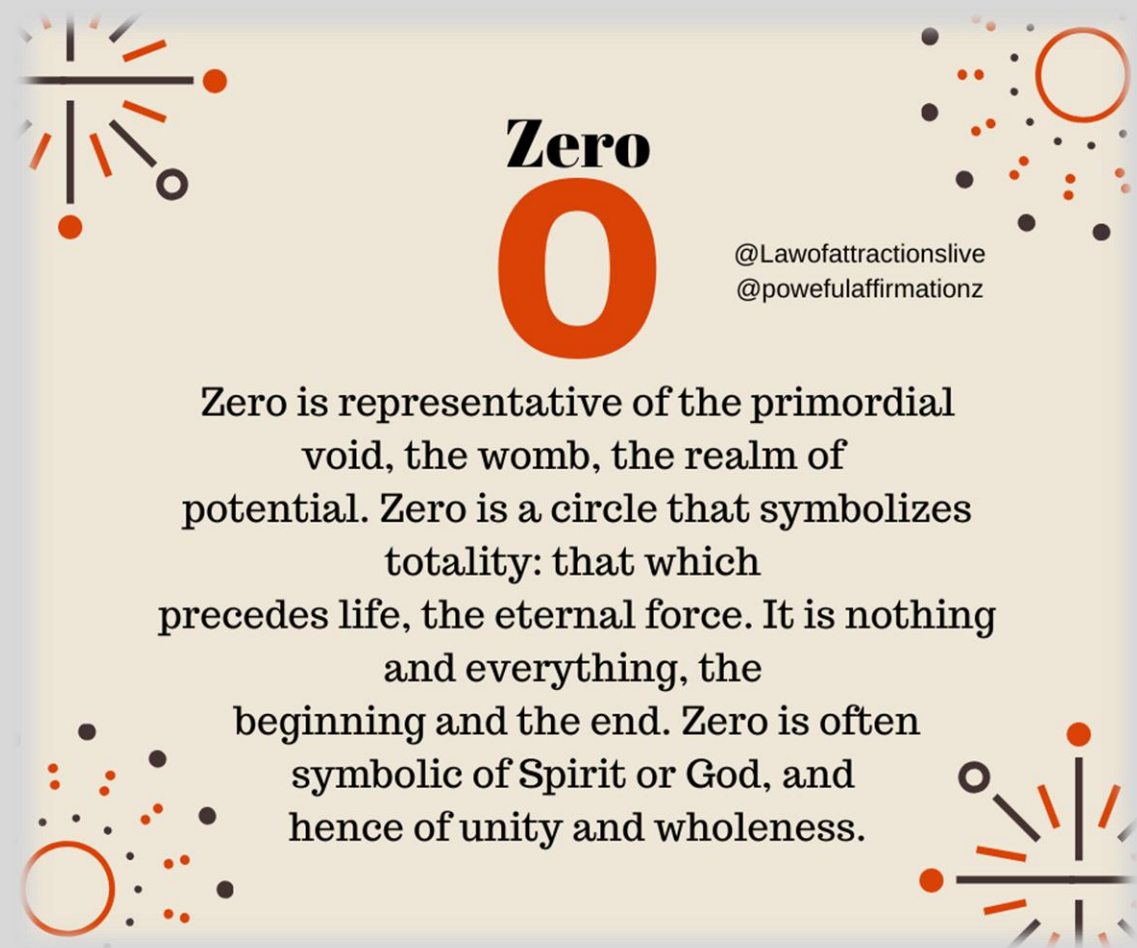


Within the magic related to numbers there are three magical paths: [Numerology](#), [Kabbalah](#) and [Gematria](#).

I don't know if I will speak about Gematria, but I will certainly speak of Kabbalah later, but for now we will focus only on numerology.

Let's talk about the first alpha-numeric number, the **number 0**.



Zero is representative of the primordial void, the womb, the realm of potential. Zero is a circle that symbolizes totality: that which precedes life, the eternal force. It is nothing and everything, the beginning and the end. Zero is often symbolic of Spirit or God, and hence of unity and wholeness.

The number 0 symbolizes nothingness, absolute emptiness; and according to the book of Genesis, the Earth was formless and empty, and there was only primordial chaos, but at one point God snapped his fingers and generated the light dispelling all the darkness when he said: "Fiat Lux", which means "Let there be Light" or "Light be made", thus giving rise to the universe according to Creationism, but according to Physics the creation of the universe is due to the Big Bang, the great primordial explosion that generated everything. As you can see, the Earth at the beginning was a **zero**, but when God gives life, it starts to have the number **one** value. God created life from a binary principle, **0** and **1**. In programming language the numbers zero and one represent the following statements: off or on, true or false, stopped or moving. Zero is the total absence of life or movement, while number one represents the first moment of life and movement.

Another fact that is not often mentioned in books on numerology is the fact that the **number zero** also represents the coiled snake or also called **ouroboros** (term originated from ancient Greek).

The **number zero** is also called a portal to the spiritual world in which, during the performance of the rituals, the opening of the portals is a circle, that is, a **number zero**.

And many times throughout the history of ancient cults, the **number zero** is portrayed as a god and was venerated as for example by the culture of the Incas who venerated him as a kind of god in the form of a serpent.

The **number zero** is also the representation of the endless void, that which has neither beginning nor end, the primordial sea where nothing existed.

The coiled snake or ouroboros also has the same meanings as the **number zero**, and sometimes that same snake appears adopting other forms such as in the form of **number eight (symbol of infinity)** and **number eighteen (sulfur sigil used in alchemy)**, but I will talk about it at the right time.

The number zero in Tarot is represented by the card **The Fool** or in a common deck its equivalent is **The Joker**. The Fool represents everything is new such new beginnings and events, everything that doesn't has experience, the chaos and spirit of change.



But it should be noted that before the creation of the Earth itself or any other physical plan, when God said: "Fiat Lux", He didn't create the physical universe in the first place, He created the spiritual universe.

When it comes to the spiritual world, He created paradise with the angels, as described in the Old Testament in the Book of Job.

Let's read what it says in the Book of Job chapter 38 and verses 4-7:

*"[4] Where were you when I laid the earth's foundation?
Tell me, if you understand.*

*[5] Who marked off its dimensions? Surely you know!
Who stretched a measuring line across it?*

*[6] On what were its footings set,
Or who laid its cornerstone—*

*[7] While the morning stars sang together
and all the angels shouted for joy?" – Book of Job.*

As you may have already understood, the entire known universe arose from this binary mathematical principle, **zero** and **one**; the other numbers appear as the result of interactions between zero and one, that is, everything started as a constant addition operation.

And returning again to the book of Genesis, as it is reported, the creation of the world follows from numerology with the counting of days, the division between day and night, the division between the heavens, lands and tides, all of which follows a mathematical principle of order in which an addition is made followed by a division which is also an addition.



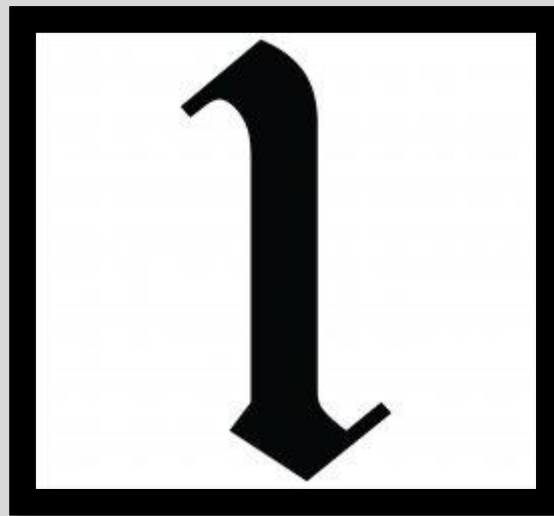
As you can understand, **dear readers**, God created everything from a dualistic principle, **but God is not dualistic!** Read the Book of John chapter 1 and verses 5 and the lesson we receive from God is this:

"This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all." – Book of John

God is the **cause of all existences without beginning and end**, He is the Light and there is no darkness in Him because everything exists because He loves us!

Duality exists only in His Creation, for example: **Man and Woman, Sun and Moon, Male and Female**, and so on...

Thus, the **number 1** is the basic principle of life and all the arising of all things from the will of God. The **number one** represents the power of **Sun** that shines the world and brings life to all, besides the number one is the representation of self-sufficiency, the awakening of consciousness, the first fertilizing principle the male.



The **number one** still represents in Tarot the first arcana, **the magician**. The **magician** represents power, dexterity and determination.

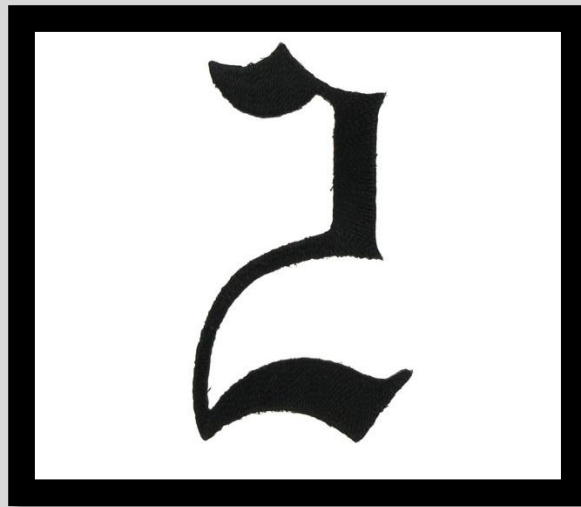


The **number 2** represents the duality and strength that maintains the balance in which God created a division in the beginning of life so that there was equality and beauty between all beings, in addition the **number two** represents the separation between the light and the darkness that occurs after Adam and Eve

eat the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil in which humanity joins Lucifer in rebellion against God, and as a punishment God expels **Adam and Eve** from Eden since they were contaminated with the evil created by the fallen angels.

Besides, the number two represents the second fertilizing power the female, and represents the moon, the night and mysteries of the dark.

The **number two** or *Duad* is the symbol of **Antagonism**; of Good and Evil, Light and Darkness, Cain and Abel, Eve and Lilith, Jachin and Boaz, Ormundz and Ahriman, Osiris and Typhon.

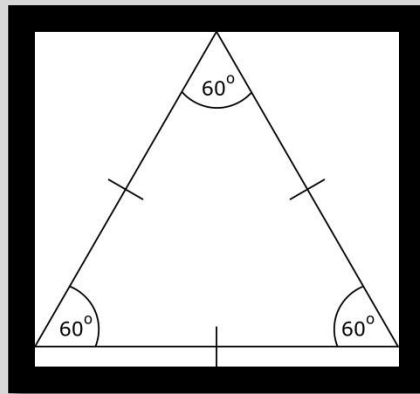


The **number two** still represents in Tarot the second arcana, **the high priestess**. **The high priestess** represents the mystery, passivity and everything that will be revealed.

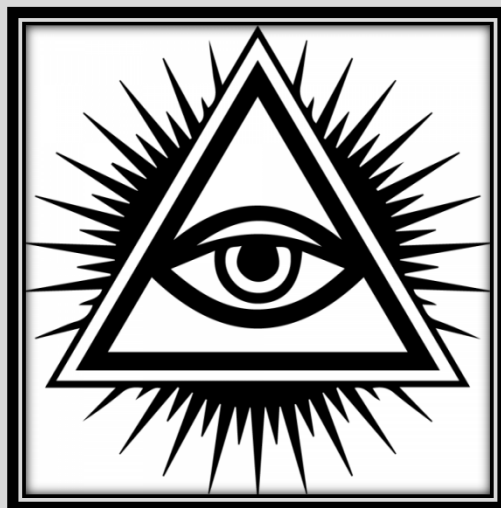


Continuing with the analysis of each number, we will now talk about **number three**. The **number three** is the representation of the conjunction of the numbers 1 and 2 which respectively represent the union of the male and the female, or also the earth (womb that generates life) and the sky (genital that spills the waters that fertilize the earth).

The **number three** is represented in magic with the equilateral triangle which has all its angles measuring 60° each, in addition the triangle with the tip facing up represents the male genital organ (penis), and the triangle with the tip facing down represents the female genital organ (vagina).



The equilateral triangle in its 3D representation is the pyramid that symbolizes the All-Seeing Eye of Freemasonry; this eye according to the masonic visions represents the eye of god, the great architect of the universe (**G.A.D.U.**), but this is a heresy. The All-Seeing Eye represents **Lucifer's eye** (sometimes also called Luciferic Vision) or vision of the third eye that opens when the practitioner of magic opens the doors of the seven chakras that are in the body.



The triangle also represents the sacred spiritual trinity: **Father, Son and Holy Spirit**. Although the concept of spiritual trinity was popularized by Catholic

doctrine, the sacred spiritual trinity is real as is attested in the New Testament of the Bible.

The same triangle can also represent the profane trinity: **Lucifer**, **Belial** and **Beelzebub**. There is also a Masonic trinity known by the acronym **Jabulon** which means respectively: Jehovah, Baal and Osiris. The same triangle is also used in several other cultures to represent a set of sacred or profane entities. The same triangle also represents the ancient cult of the Sun that existed in several ancient cultures and is also related to the cult of fertility.



In Christianity the triangle represents the three theological virtues: **Faith**, **hope** and **charity**. It's also worth mentioning that the sacred trinity is also represented as a **single entity**, it's worth remembering what is written in the book of Genesis, according to which the name given to God is **ELOHIM** (in this name the three sacred identities of the Creator are circumscribed) or also called **IMMANUEL** (this name means "God with us").

See the book of Genesis chapter 1 and verse 1:

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." – Book of Genesis

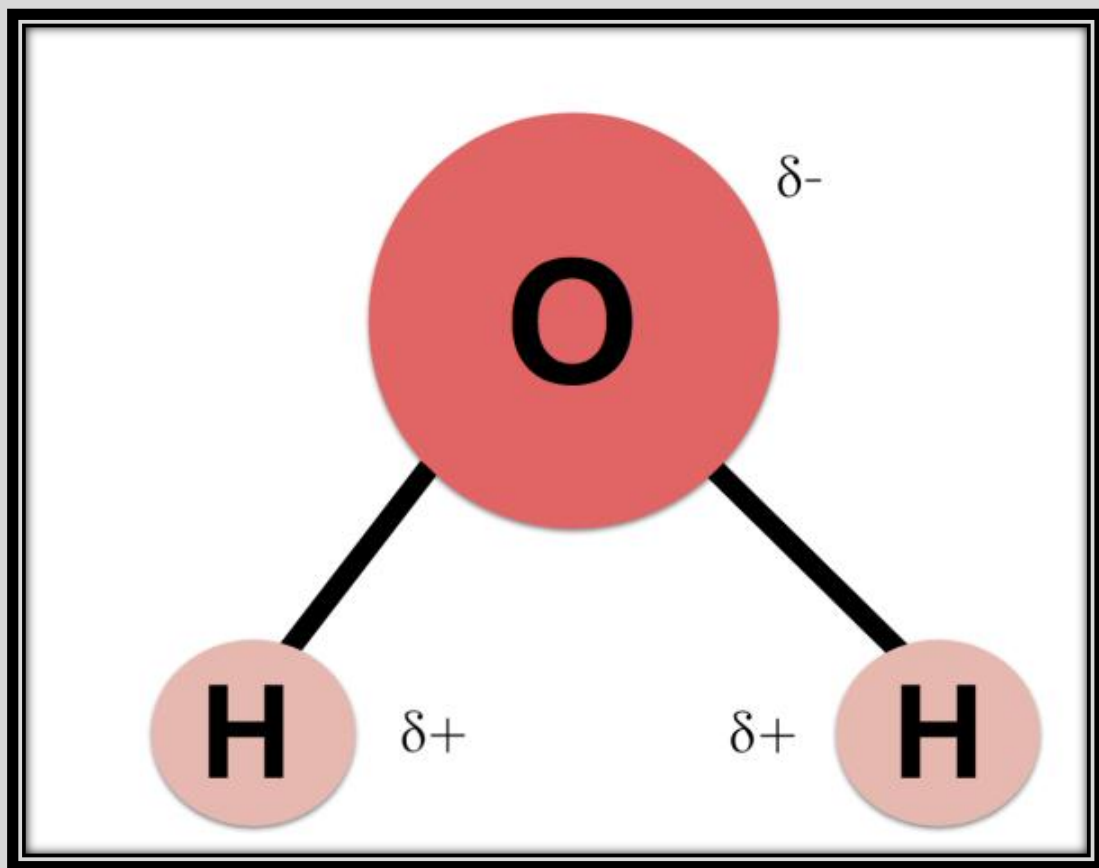
And also see Matthew's Gospel chapter 1 verses 22-23:

*"[22] All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet.
[23] The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him
Immanuel (which means "God with us")." – Matthew's Gospel*

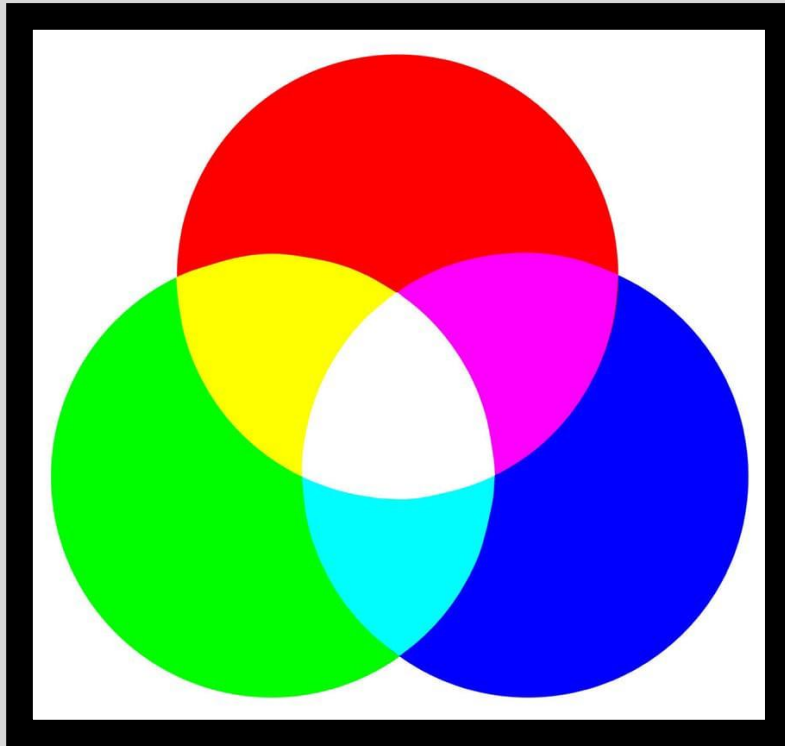
The **number three** also alludes to the three spheres of the existence of human life: **Material**, **rational** and **spiritual**. The triangle also represents the spiritual fire that illuminates the soul and in alchemy the triangle represents the sacred elements: **Sulfur** (S), **Salt** (Na) and **Mercury** (Hg).

The triangle is the main symbol of invocation of entities related to the elements of air, earth and water.

Returning again to the book of Genesis, according to reports, God is also represented as the immaterial waters (or spiritual waters) that bring life and throughout the history of mankind many civilizations have established cults to the waters or gods that control the waters since water is the basic element of life from which all beings derive their sustenance. Observe the atomic structure of the water which also obeys a pyramid scheme, see the illustration below:



The triangle is also described as a representation of the intermixture between the three primary colors that generate all the other colors of the rainbow; this system is called RGB (**R**ed, **G**reen & **B**lue).



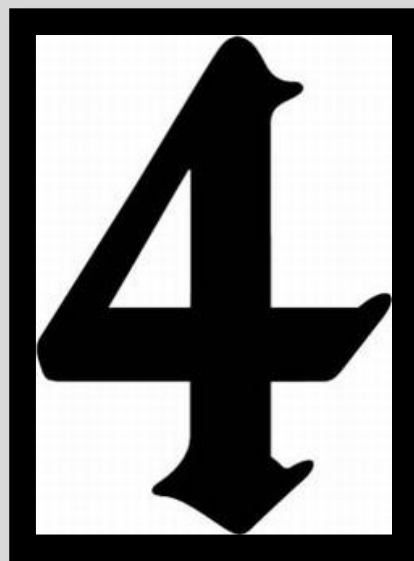
Concluding this extensive list of descriptions of the number three with some more data, according to Kabbalah, the immaterial man is composed of vitality (breath of life), mind and spirit.

As you can see one more time, **dear readers**, **the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit** worked together for the creation of the world in perfect union and synchrony, and between them there can be no separation, because Jesus said to Samaritan woman: "Whoever be thirsty come, for whoever drinks the water of life will never be thirsty". We need to keep in mind that the number three and its mathematical representation through the triangle represent the essence of God, but the envious and arrogant Devil imitates him in an attempt to create confusion in humanity and the secret societies distort God's law and the principles of life to attract others into the pitfalls of magic to profit from the mistakes they profess to anyone who seeks these societies seeking to want to understand the Creator.

Read Romans chapter 1 and verse 25:

"They exchanged the truth about God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator – who is praised forever. Amen." –
Romans

And the number three in Tarot is equivalent to the third arcana, **the empress**. **The empress** is associated to the creation of life, art and the beginning of new family. And this number represents Jupiter (not only the planet, but the god Jupiter in the Ancient Roman Empire or Ancient Greece Zeus).



Now it's time for **number four**! The **number four** is associated with the geometric representation of the square and in its 3D perspective as a cube, and in the Bible the number four is a constant number that signals the fulfillment of the word of God according to the book of Revelations.

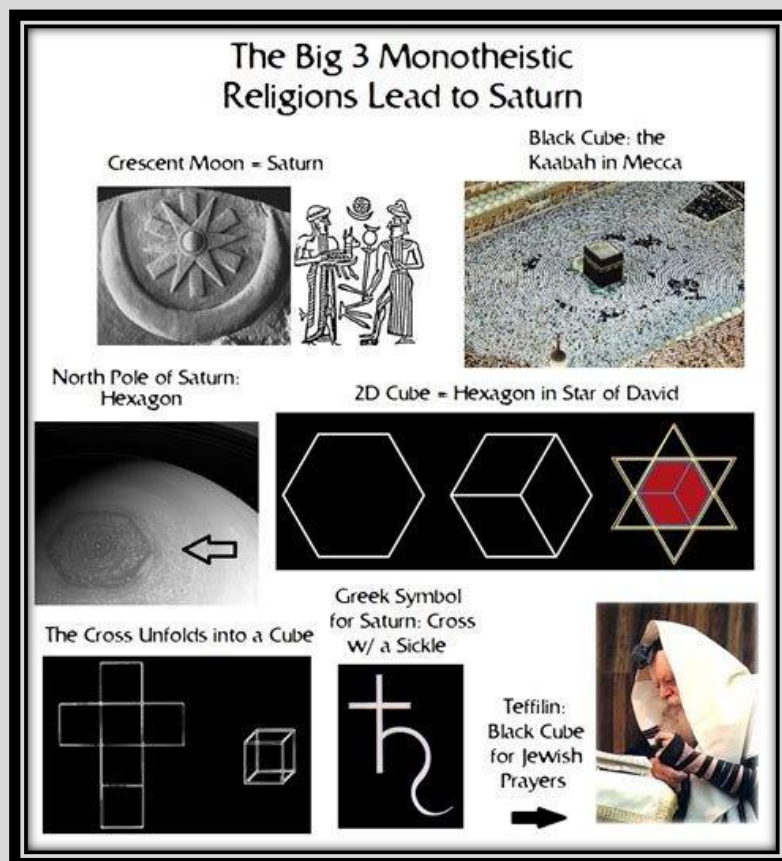
Read Revelations chapter 7 and verse 1:

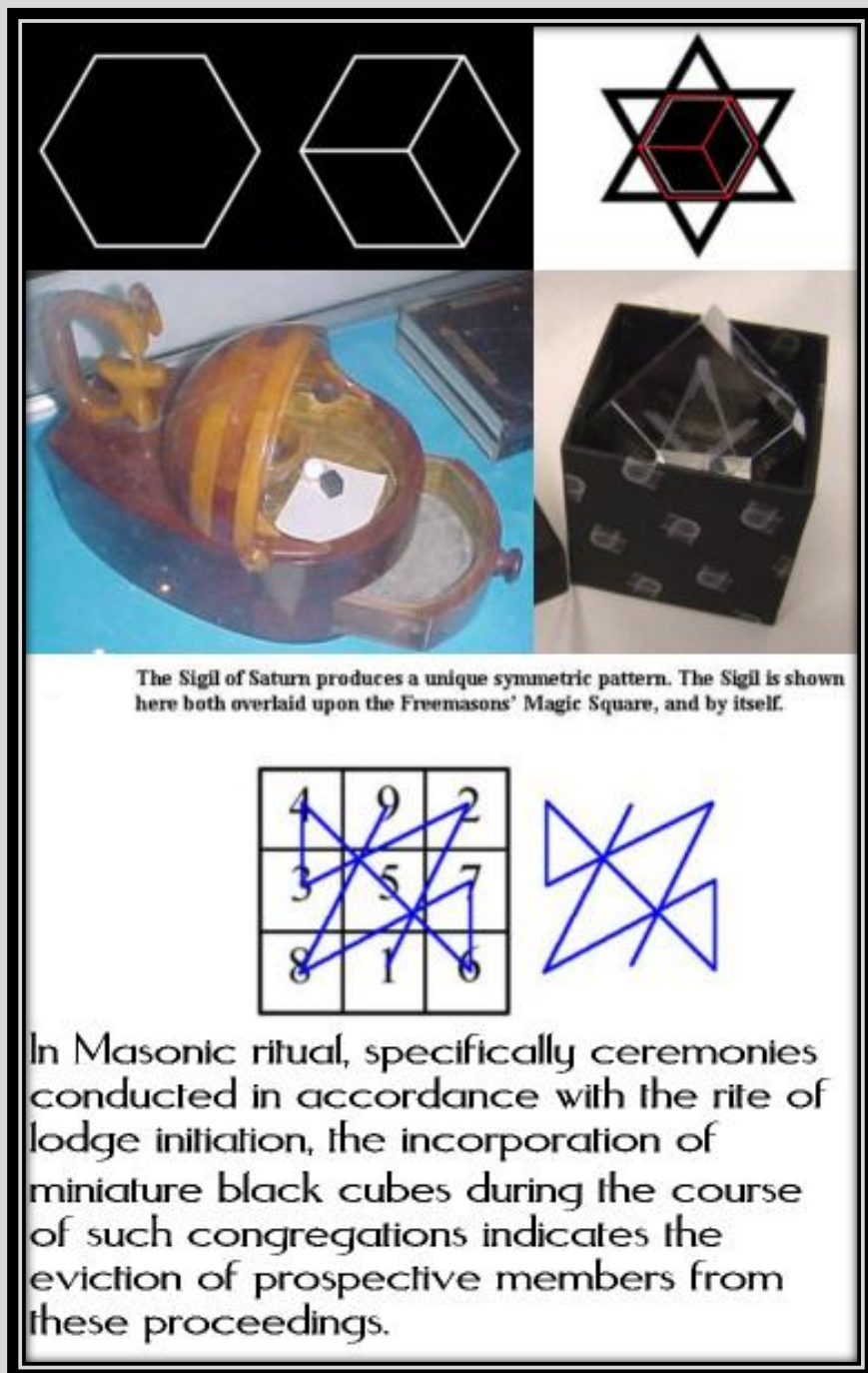
"After this I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding back the four winds of the earth to prevent any wind from blowing on the land or on the sea or any tree." – Book of Revelations

Note that the book of Revelations or also called **Apocalypse** which means revelation also contains **22 chapters** as well as the Tarot which contains **22 arcanas**, as well as also representing the **22 letters** of the Hebrew alphabet; so now sum up the numbers 2+2 that result is the **number 4**.

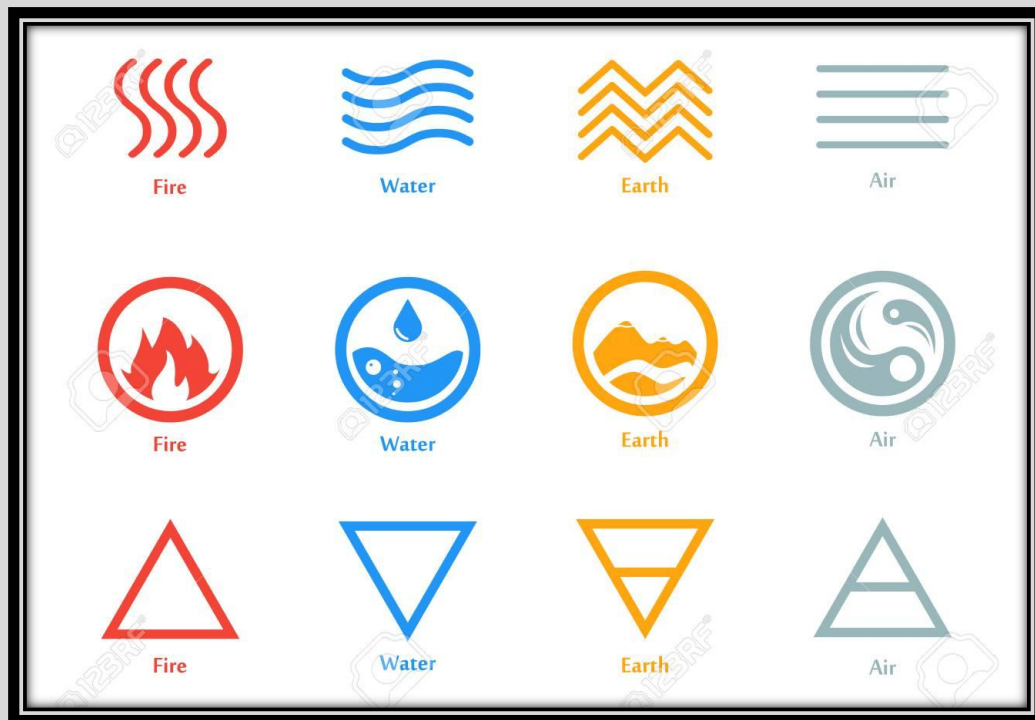
The **number four** is the number that makes the association with the four horsemen of the Apocalypse who will ride on Earth, beginning the counting of the days for the return of the Messiah and the appearance of the New Jerusalem.

The New Jerusalem would have a cubic shape and this cube will descend from the heavens, so the cube is the image of the representation of heaven or also called **fourth dimension** (for some, this fourth dimension is called invisible world).





The **number four** is also a representation of the four elements that generate life and bring balance to the Earth, they are: **water**, **earth**, **fire** and **air**. These elements are the forces of nature and the power given to angels to manifest phenomena with these elements, be they storms, earthquakes, tidal waves, etc.



Speaking specifically of the hierarchy of angels, see that they are divided into: **Seraphim, Cherubs, Thrones, Dominations, Powers, Virtues, Principalities, Archangels and Angels.**



Note that according to the book of Enoch, those responsible for the fall of mankind were the **fallen angels** who taught men the doctrines of magic by corrupting mankind by making it greedy and perverse.

Remember also that the true angels who obey God aren't corrupt and don't act to defile mankind, the goal of the angels who respond directly to God's orders is to guide mankind towards its approach to God and to remove the influence of the demonic powers and principalities.

The fallen angels according to books 1 and 2 of Kings of the Bible report that the fallen angels taught men the doctrines of mathematics, chemistry, astrology, languages, magic and engineering; and by teaching these doctrines the fallen angels taught how men could invoke them in this world through the invocation of the **black cube**, highly used in Freemasonry and other secret societies as you saw above.

Don't forget that we should not label the image of the cube as something totally demonic since, as we saw earlier, the cube is the representation of the heavens but the fallen angels also use the same geometric representation to deceive man.

Still talking a little more about the number four we can also mention the river that surrounded the Eden and was divided into four smaller headwaters as mentioned in the book of Genesis chapter 2 verses 10-14:

"[10] A river watering the garden flowed from Eden; from there it was separated into four headwaters.

*[11] The name of the first is the **Pishon**; it winds through the entire land of Havilah, where there is gold.*

[12] The gold of that land is good; aromatic resin and onyx are also there.

*[13] The name of the second river is **Gihon**; it winds through the entire land of Cush.*

*[14] The name of the third river is **Tigris**; it runs along the east side of Ashur. And the fourth river is the **Euphrates**." – Book of Genesis*

The **number four** can be said as the signature number of the Earth and the actions of the angels. The prophet **Zechariah** had a vision in which he saw four chariots and four horsemen, and these horsemen are the four horsemen of the Apocalypse.

The prophet **Ezekiel** saw four creatures with four faces each, in addition to four pairs of wings, and these creatures are cherubs.

In the book of Psalms, reading **Psalms 148** it is clear that praise to God is performed with four songs of praise and repeated four times.

The number four also symbolizes the four cardinal points that cut across the Earth and they are: **North**, **South**, **East** and **West**.

Another interesting fact about number four is in the official video for the song "Meet Me Halfway" by the band Black Eyed Peas. In the video we see a clear reference to the fall of mankind symbolized by the figures of **Adam** and **Eve**,

and the key to entering paradise or portal to the heavens is represented by a cube.

Another interesting and eccentric fact about the **number four** is that the number four in the east is seen as an unlucky number and is related to the summoning of the demons and night spirits that frighten mankind.

It's common in countries like Japan and China in small towns that people avoid the **number four**, there are street records in Japan where some houses that should have the number four as identification doesn't exist; they just skip the number four just as some Brazilians avoid the **number thirteen** (the number thirteen is the sum of **1 + 3 = 4**).

In the video game Harvest Moon on PlayStation 1, if you access the house that has a TV at exactly **4:44 AM** at exactly this moment when the TV is turned on it will display a text box with the following message:

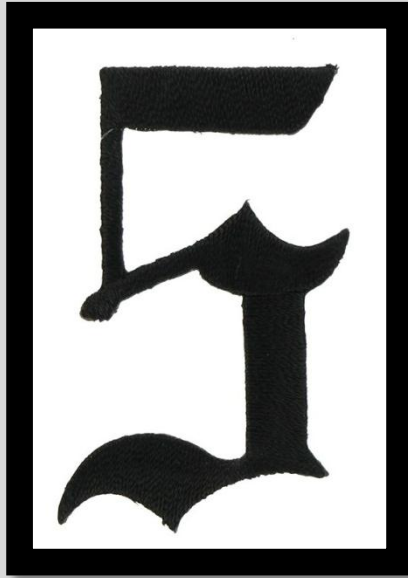
If that happens, the game will crash and you will have to restart it. This is a warning of how much the Orientals fear the number four.

Also the **number four** in Tarot symbolizes the fourth major arcana, **the emperor**.

The emperor is associated to stability and security, an addiction to authority, law and order, power and leadership.

And of course, the number four is related to **Uranus**, but sometimes is related to **Saturn** just like the **number eight** is related to this planet too.





Now let's talk about **number five**. The **number five** is the fertility archetype and represents some of the following values: **ardor**, **vital force** and **aggressiveness**.

The number five is also called the golden number and is related to human beings and nature.

According to some books on iconology, the **number five** is described as a number of growth and natural harmony, in addition to being a symbol of the androgynous since this number is the ambivalent result of the sum between the number **two** (female) and **three** (male), after number **one** (creative principle).

The **number five** is also the representation of the pentagram or pentalpha (or also called blazing star), a star in which the human body is inscribed with its extremities extended, each touching one of the four angles and the head, the fifth.

The same pentagram represented with its tip facing downwards is responsible for the summoning of demons; being specific this star is called the Star of Astaroth (one of the demons of King Solomon's Goetia). The inverted pentagram also represents the invocation of the **Goat of Mendes** by Eliphas Levi.

Goat of Mendes aka Baphomet

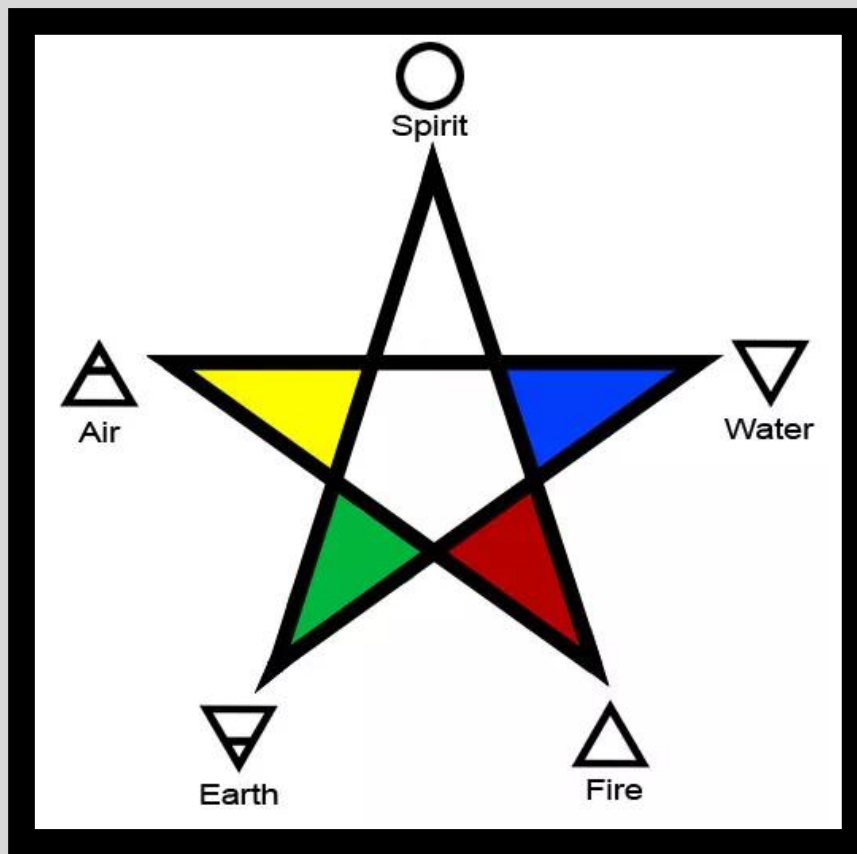
There are also differences in meaning between the symbols pentagram, pentalpha, pentagrammon and pentacle with regard to their powers, but for the sake of objectivity I will not address the subject here, but if you want I can clarify the differences in the future.

What is clear about the study of number five and the pentagram is that both represent health, vital force, conjuration of mystical energies, and union through marriage between man and woman, and knowledge.

According to **Hermes Trimegistos**, an alchemist from Ancient Egypt, each man on the face of the Earth is a star with its own power and light, but I must point out this is a heresy. As we saw earlier, the only being in the universe that really carries light and emanates it to the entire universe is **God**, so no man can be a god since man doesn't emanate its own light; he is only a fragment of the will of God.

The **number five** is also widely worshiped in the Islamic world because it is the favorite number that governs the sacredness of rituals such as marriage. In the macrocosm of Islamic mysticism, the elements that originate life are five, they are: **water, air, ether, fire and earth**.

In the microcosm of Islamic mysticism, there are five senses that guide the lives of living beings, they are: **touch, smell, taste, hearing and vision**.



Around the 13th and 14th centuries in Spain, the **number five** was also considered a talisman against evil and it was common for people to say when they felt close to people with bad energies the following phrase: "five in your eye" or "five over your eye".

Another interesting curiosity is that each angle formed by the five-pointed star has the measurements of **72°** and **108°**, and if you sum up the respective numbers we find the number nine as a result. I'll not discuss here the relation between the numbers **five** and **nine** because we don't waste time with any complex relationships between these numbers.

Christ fed His disciples and the multitude with five loaves and two fishes; and of the fragments there remained twelve, that is, **five** and **seven** baskets full. Again He fed them with seven loaves and a few little fishes, and there remained **seven baskets full**. The **five** apparently small planets, Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, and Saturn, with the two greater ones, the Sun and Moon, constituted the **seven celestial spheres**.

And we cannot forget that the **number five** in Tarot is associated with five major arcana, **the hierophant**.

The hierophant represents the marriage, spiritual guidance, advice and learning.

And also the number five represents **Mercury**.



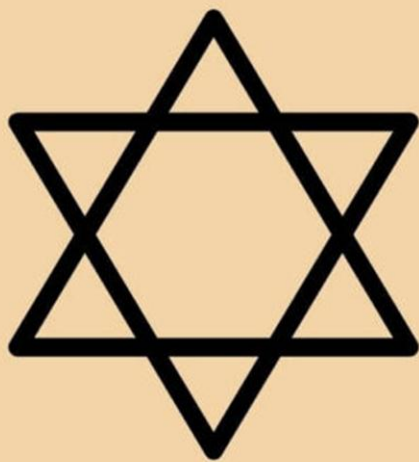
Continuing our analysis of the magic meaning of numbers, we now move on to **number six**.

The **number six** represents the esoteric figure of man who was created on the Sixth Day of Divine Creation according to the book of Genesis, but we must be aware about this fact because this is a symbolic language that marks the birth of the living Adam, the material man who was born in the image and likeness of God. This same man who was honored with the keys of the garden of God rebelled when he ate the fruit of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

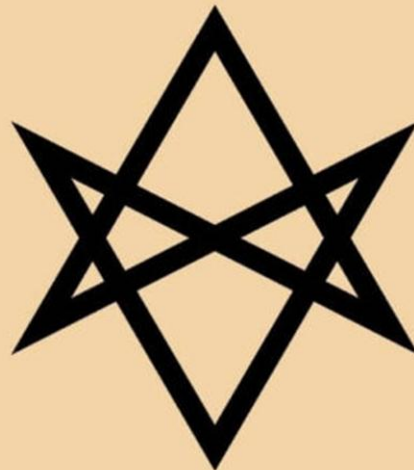


The **number six** (or in Latin, **sex**) also represents the principle of material creation and is also related to values: balance, light, achievement, discernment and wisdom.

The **number six** is represented geometrically by the hexagram or also called the sigil of Solomon as it was used by **King Solomon** as a key to purge demonic forces, since the five-pointed star or pentagram is used to conjure spiritual energies and to trap them.

The hexagram is also known as star of Moloch, the term Star of David is an error. The hexagram was not a prize or talisman used by David after defeating the Philistine army as a sign of gratitude given by God, in fact this symbol first appeared during the reign of his second son, **Solomon**. Solomon was considered to be one of the wisest and wealthiest men ever to exist on Earth and much of this is due to the fact that over time, **Solomon** turned away from God and began to approach the pagan cultures of the time and the greatest cult that existed at that time was the cult to Moloch.

The cult of Moloch, a demonic entity that has the head of a bull and a human body but may also appear to have a pig's head, required from its worshipers the practice of infanticide (sacrificing children through cremation in a large furnace) that should be offered on dates such as winter solstice and among others to pay for the graces granted by the gods.

Let's read the book of 1 Kings, chapter 11 and verse 4-8:

"[04] As Solomon grew old, his wives turned his heart after other gods, and his heart was not fully devoted to the Lord his God, as the heart of David his father had been.

[05] He followed Ashtoreth the goddess of Sidonians, and Molek the detestable god of Ammonites.

[06] So Solomon did evil in the eyes of the Lord; he did not follow the Lord completely, as David his father had done.

[07] On a hill of Jerusalem, Solomon built a high place for Chemosh the detestable god of Moab, and for Molek the detestable god of the Ammonites.

[08] He did the same for all his foreign wives, who burned incense and offered sacrifices to their gods." – 1 Kings

The hexagram isn't a symbol of divine protection or a symbol that exalts pride as it is on the flag of the state of Israel. The hexagram is a symbol used to banish energies.



The hexagram as you can also observe is a symbol of union between the male and the female through the use of equilateral triangles with the points pointing up and down showing the union of the male and the female that fertilizes the earth, therefore the **number six** is called the **number of material creation** since it is related to everything that is mundane, that is, it belongs to the physical world.

The number six also represents ambivalence as it combines opposing forces that cancel each other out like fire and water.

The hexagram is also intrinsically related to the close balance of peace and justice. An interesting curiosity about the hexagram reports that, according to some Arab legends, the same symbol was engraved on King Solomon's ring.



Also note that when we join the **number five** (representation of the star) and the **number six** (representation of the carnal man) we get the **number 11**. The **number eleven** is a number that represents the two main columns that were at the entrance to Solomon's temple, Jachin and Boaz. Each column has a value of 1.



The **number eleven** is an affront and blasphemy number in which **Lucifer** claims to be above **God**, since God is also represented by the **number 10**, the union of the numbers one and zero, that is, the alpha (first letter of the Greek alphabet) and the omega (last letter of the Greek alphabet), so God is the beginning and the end of all things and no one is above the Creator!
No man can be god!

The **number six** also refers to everything that is imperfect and carnal, and therefore does not share any relationship with the sacred; a profane number and taken as a **sign of evil**.

The **number six** in Jewish theological doctrine symbolizes the evil, but when we have three numbers six, that is, **the triple six (666)**, that number marks the manifestation of **Antichrist** or also called as the son of perdition, a man of sin. The **number 666** makes reference to the ancient emperor of Rome, **Nero**. **Nero** set fire to the empire itself, killing thousands of people.



Antichrist will be the one who will destroy the law of God and make the world fall into Lucifer's great deception during the last days before Christ's return, he will walk to the world performing great miracles and will be worshiped as a god, but during his reign of some years, he will show his true face to the world and many will ask to die but will not be able to because they have been marked with the mark of the beast.

The mark of the beast will be an **electronic control system that will collect all your data constantly and will also monitor you** giving to Antichrist omnipotence, omniscience and omnipresence; and without this mark, **no human being will be able to buy or sell since physical money will cease to exist.**

The mark of the beast will also act as a new legal system that will rule the world and will impose **new laws** through international meetings and courts defining the action of each human being, even if that is the force.

Read the book of Revelations, chapter 13 and verses 16-18:

“[16] It also forced all people, great and small, rich and poor, free or slave, to receive a mark on their right hands or on their foreheads,

[17] so that they could not buy or sell unless they had the mark, which is the name of the beast or the number of its name.

[18] This calls for wisdom. Let the person who has insight calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man. That number is 666.” – Book of Revelations

As we have seen so far, the **number six** is related to all things mundane and in Gematria the numbers six and nine are related to the evil.

And during the beginning of the tribulation, the Antichrist will demand to be worshiped as a god and he will try to lead many people to eternal damnation and few will be those who will persevere and see the truth as described in the book of Matthew chapter 7 and verses 13-14:

"[13] Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it.

[14] But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it." – Book of Matthew

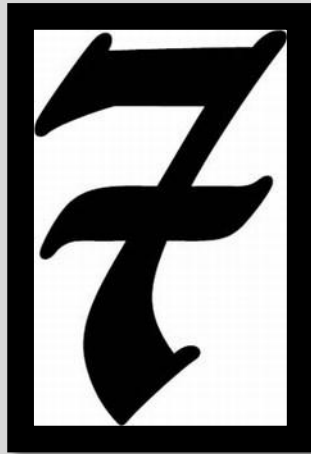
The **number six** is related in the Tarot to the sixth arcana, **the lovers**.

The lovers are represented by the couple who were in Eden, but were expelled by God for cooperating with the fallen angels in the act of rebellion.

This is a dualistic arcana in which its power is directed towards good as well as evil, as well as the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

The Lovers symbolize the power of choice and free will. The **number six** is related to the planet **Venus** which is also called "Estrela D'Alva", an allusion to Lucifer, the former morning star.





The **number seven** is the number that represents God and his omniscience, as well as representing everything that is related to the manifestation of God's will.

The **number seven** appears in the Holy Scriptures in the following references: seven are the spirits that are before the throne of God, at the end of the creation of the universe God rested on the seventh day and demanded that his people keep this day to worship him and you know this day like the Saturday which is related to the word Sabbath which means Saturday, seven are the golden candlesticks that adorned the temple of Solomon, seven are the angels that were manifested during Christ's return, seven are the seals that correspond to the fulfillment of the word of God in the Book of Revelations, seven are the trumpets that sounded announcing the final judgment on the whole earth, seven are the cups of wrath and so on.

Let's read Revelation chapter 1 and verses 2-4:

"[2] who testifies to everything he saw – that is, the word of God and the testimony of Jesus Christ.

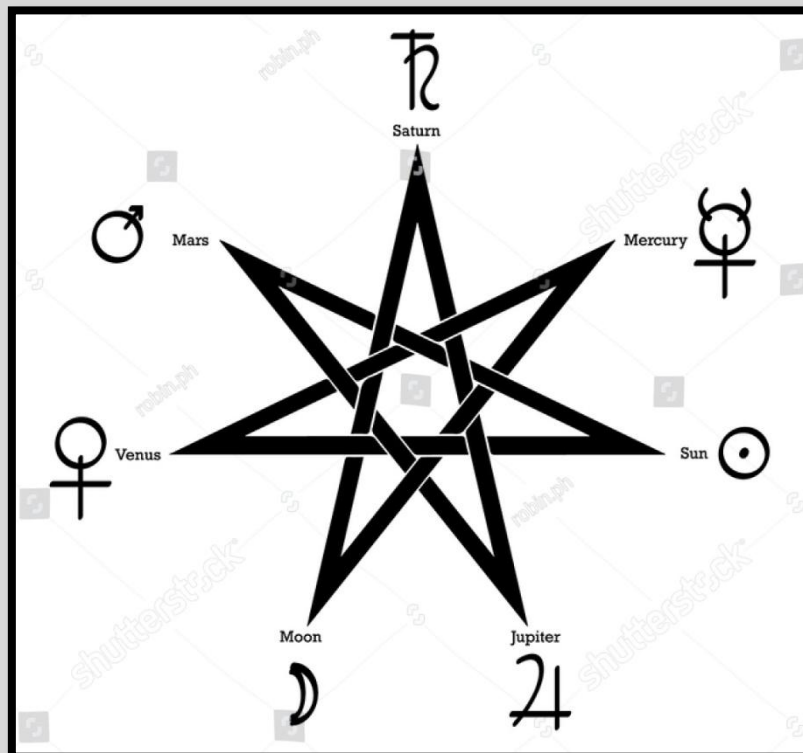
[3] Blessed is the one who reads aloud the words of this prophecy, and blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it, because the time is near.

*[4] John, to the seven churches in the province of Asia:
Grace and peace to you from him who is, and who was, and who is to come,
and from the seven spirits before his throne."* – Revelation

The duration of a lunar quarter corresponds to seven days, the seven-pointed star also called the septagram or heptagram corresponds to the seven planets or spheres commanded by the archangels, seven are the colors of the rainbow. The number seven represents the principle of beauty in the forms of love, union, rebirth, perfection and harmony.

Speaking in geometric terms, the **number seven** corresponds to the connection between the square (cube) and the triangle (pyramid), that is, the fusion between the **numbers three** (sacred trinity) and the **number four** (celestial powers).

Here is the heptagram, check the image below:



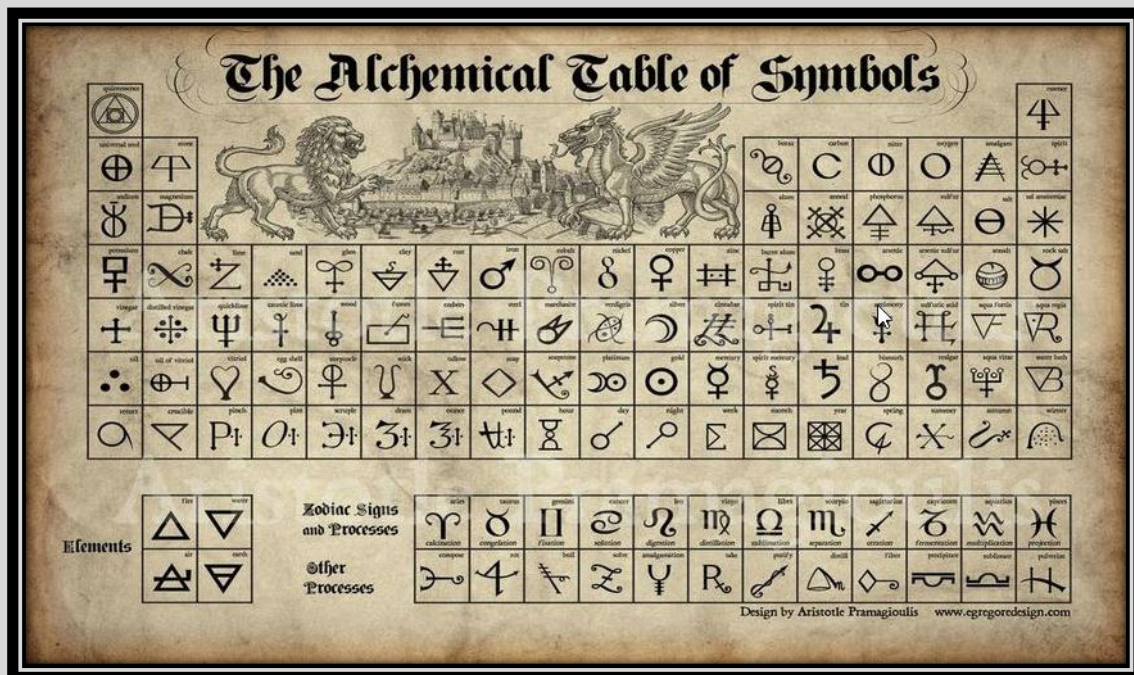
Seven are the arms that make up a Jewish menorah. The **number seven** represents the essential range of sounds, colors, planets, capital sins and virtues.

Going back to the Bible, the **number 7 appears 77** and joining the numbers we have the **number 777** (the mark of God).



The **number seven** in alchemy is related to the steps that must be overcome to reach the upper level and thus find the philosopher's stone, and the steps that

form this ladder are: Calcination, Sublimation, Solution, Putrefaction, Distillation, Coagulation and Dye.



Anyway, the **number seven** is related to so many things and spiritual phenomena that to talk about all of them, I would have to write a little book just about it because there are many curious facts.

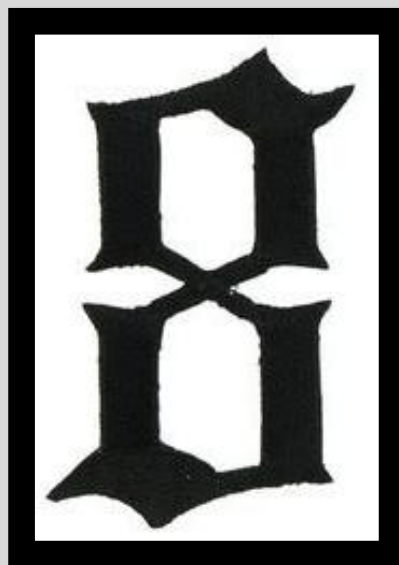
Bringing just one more fact about the **number seven**, this number is related to luck and the prosperity cult, and maybe if you've ever seen how a slot machine works in a casino, then you know that the biggest payout that you can win on this machine if you manage to hit a straight with three consecutive numbers seven.



The **number seven** is associated in the tarot with the seventh arcana, **the chariot**.

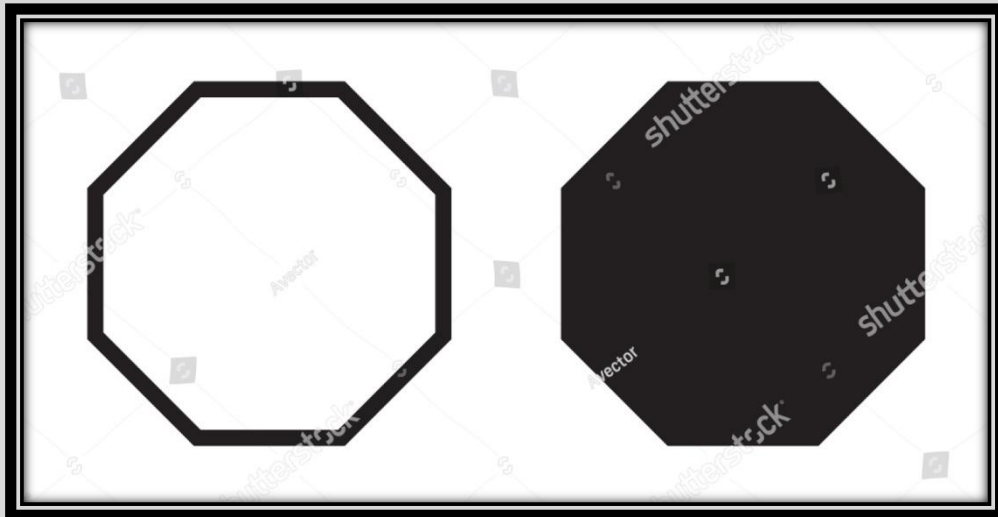
The chariot represents the overcoming of problems and walks towards the light, in addition to representing ambition, willpower and confidence.

The **number seven** is related to the planet **Neptune**, the ancient primordial waters of life.



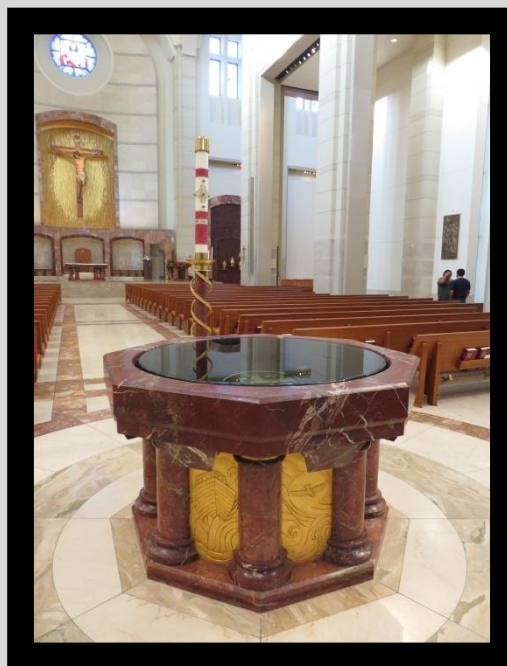
Talking now about the **number eight** (in Latin, octo), it is the number of cosmic balance and the principle of life that never ends, remember of **Ouroboros** the coiled snake that bites its own tail signaling for cyclic life that never has an end. This number is also related to resurrection and intelligence.

The **number eight** has the octagon as a geometric representation, a figure formed by the intersection of two squares, and the octagon is the equidistant geometric figure that is between the square (the terrestrial order) and the circle (eternal order).



It is also the number of balance, justice and regeneration, in addition to being the number of baptismal waters.

It is common in ancient baptisms that the sink usually has an octagonal plan.



The **number eight** is also widely used in High Magic to invoke the serpent through the symbol of infinity, and the serpents that form the symbol of infinity represent antagonistic forces such as fire and water.

These serpents that intertwine appear around the caduceus, the rod of Asclepius, Roman and Greek god of medicine. The same snakes appear on Baphomet's lap, circling his penis.



The **number eight** also represents the spiral movement of the skies and our galaxy, the Milky Way.

The **number eight** is also related to the resurrection because **Christ** was resurrected on the eighth day if we count the days when he suffered on Mount Calvary and the act of carrying the cross to this place add up to eight days. The eight also symbolizes the ancient leviathan, which is also a serpent.



Finally, the **number eight** in the tarot is equivalent to **the strength** and **the justice** arcanas. The **number eight** also represents the planet **Saturn**. **The strength** represents confidence, inner strength, virility and vitality, while **the justice** represents balance, cause and effect, fairness and justice.



We are almost at the end of the first part and we are going to the penultimate number, **number nine**.

Also called the synthesis number of the principle of creation and also the highest number revered in alchemy, the **number nine** is a square of the number three and it is a spiral that joins the three existing worlds: **heaven**, **earth** and **hell**.

The **number nine** for having its point pointing downwards represents hell as we attest in the work Comedia by Dante Alighieri in which there are nine hellish circles where all sinners who do not receive the salvation of Christ are destined, while the **number six** for having its pointing upwards symbolizes the heaven.



In esoteric numerology, the **number nine** is related to the goose, a bird that represents the initiation of the pilgrimage; and according to Dante Alighieri the **number nine** also represents carnal love.

For the Hebrews, the **number nine** is the representation of the virtue of Truth since when multiplied, it reproduces itself, and it always generates the **number nine**.

Check the image below and sum the results of these multiplications and you always will find the **number 9**.

For the Egyptians, the **number nine** was called "**Mountain of the Sun**" and represented the essence of life and was symbolized by the trinity: **Osiris**, **Isis** and **Horus**. This trinity represents the evolution of the three spiritual planes as well as the triple synthesis: **divine**, **natural** and **intelligence**.

Freemasonry inherited love for the **number nine** of the Egyptians as well as the Templars who worshiped it as representing immortality, but the **number nine** also represents death and the end of life.

The **number nine** is constantly associated with evil as well as the **number six** since both are the same number, but are only inverted. The **numbers nine** and **six** act as opposing forces, for example, they are **Ying and Yang**.

In the Bible, the number nine always appears in verses related to evil and catastrophes such as when Jesus Christ died on the cross; read the gospel of Mark chapter 15 and verses 33-34:

*"[33] At noon, darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon.
[34] And at three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, 'Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?' (which means 'My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?')". – Mark*

The **number nine** as well as the numbers **three** and **six** share the same multiples and when we perform the sum of its results after making a multiplication we always find the numbers **3**, **6** and **9**, both are multiples of three. The **number eighteen** is also classified as the number of the beast because **6x3 is 18**, and **1 + 8 is 9**.



In the book of Revelation in chapter 9 and verse 11, the name of the angel of the abyss is mentioned and he will be released once more into the world to torment mankind. The **numbers 9** and **11** are the favorites among **Satanists** to invoke evil. **Nine** and **six** are the same number because represent the evil, and

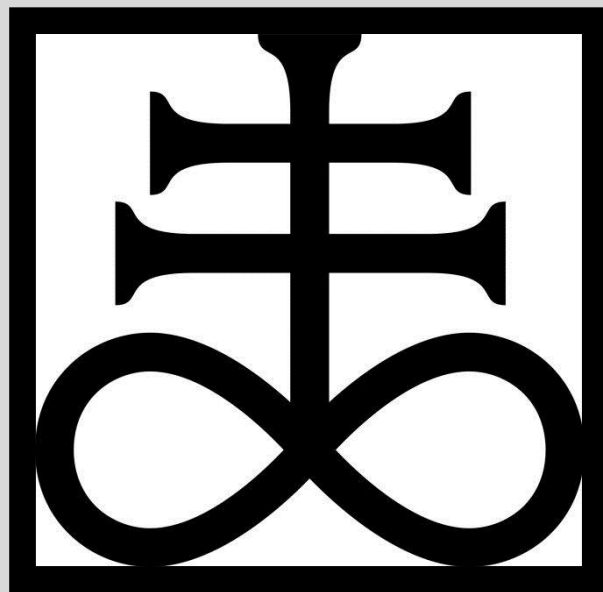
eleven is a blasphemy against God since some part of mankind considers **Lucifer** the true god, but this is false.
Read Revelation below:

“They had a king over them the angel of the Abyss, whose name in Hebrew is Abaddon and Greek is Apollyon (that is, Destroyer).” – Revelation

The **number six** in Babylonian digits is represented by the **letter X** and three XXX is equal to **666**, this three-letter acronym x is used for pornographic websites.

And also talking a little bit more about **number eighteen**, as I talked previously this number is a representation of the mark of beast and the invocation of the ancient serpent (Satan), pay attention to the Sulfur Sigil used in Alchemy because this drawing is a combination of the numbers **1** and **8**, but the number **8** is rotated 90° to the left, and the number appears like the **symbol of infinity**, and the number **1** is above the number **8**. The Sulfur Sigil is called to Leviathan Cross.

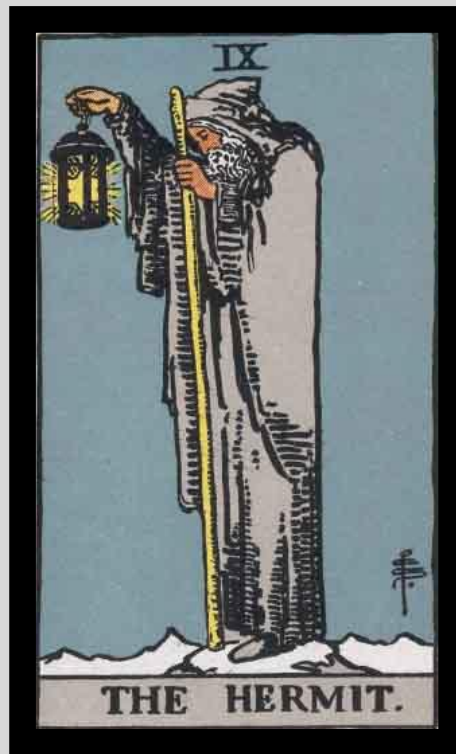
Check the image below:



In Tarot, the **number nine** is related to the ninth arcana, the hermit. Also the number is associated with the planet **Mars**.

The hermit symbolizes introspection, meditation, self-reflection and solitude. The hermit is an old man carrying a staff in one hand and a lit lantern containing a six-pointed star in the other hand.

The hermit suggests that you are in a phase of introspection where you are drawing your attention inwards and looking for answers within. You are in need of a period of inner reflection, away from the current demands of your position.



Concluding this first part of our analysis of the numbers, we move on to the last number, the **number ten**.

As I said in other previous paragraphs about numbers **one** and **zero**, I gave details about the function of each one and their interactions, but just to remember again, the **number 10** is the junction of the numbers **1** and **0**, each representing respectively the beginning and the end of all things, or also the existential emptiness and principle of life, which is **God**.

Read the book of Revelation chapter 22 and verse 13:

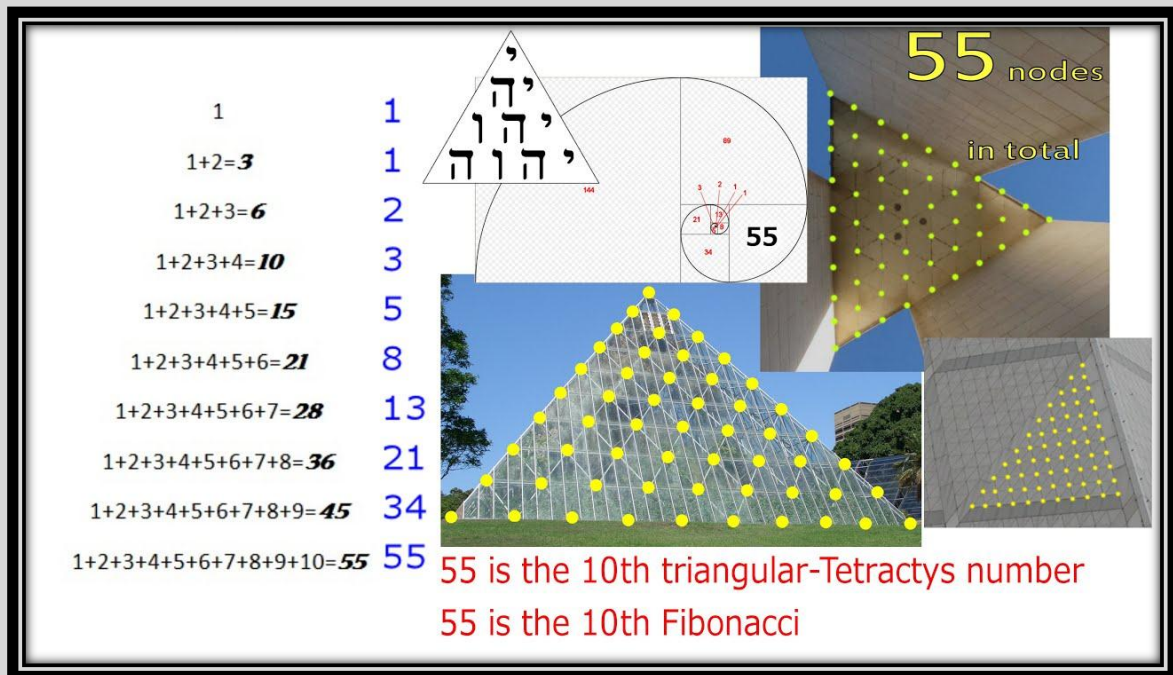
"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End." – Revelation



In addition, the **number 10** includes all the other previous numbers, and is specially represented through the **Tetractys** of Pythagoras that gathers the sum of the first four numbers: **1 + 2 + 3 + 4**.

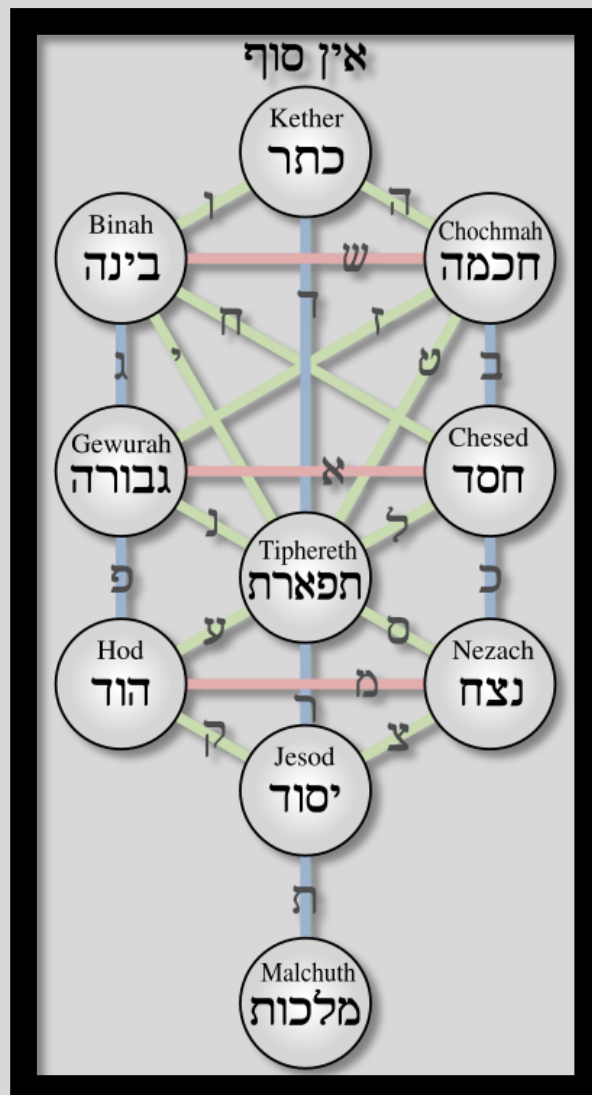
The first four numbers represent the principle of life, the heavenly actions of angels, the sacred trinity and the balance of life.

The **Tetractys** can appear to be represented by a set of dots or yöds (a letter that is generally used in Hebrew to represent **God**). See the figure below:



The **number ten**, according to the Pythagoreans, is the number of perfection and synthesis of life, in addition to being the symbol of fullness being worshiped in all cultures on Earth, since mankind learned to count using his fingers.

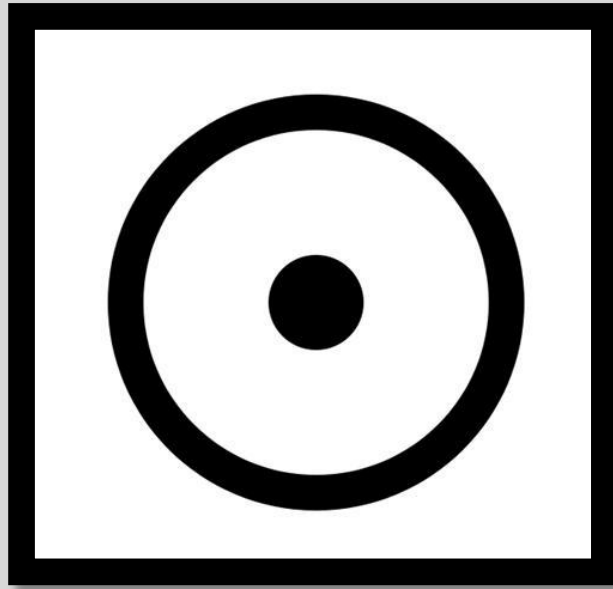
This number also represents the exact number of spheres that make up the tree of the kabbalah and each of its spheres is called sephirot, according to the cabbalists in this tree are the ten names of God: Eheie, Yah, El, Elohim, Eloi, Gibor, Eloah, YHVH Sabaoth, Elohim Sabaoth, Shadai e Adonai.



The number ten can also display some interesting connections with the **circumpoint**.

The circumpoint, circle dot or "circle with dot in the center" as the name says is a circle with a dot in the middle or in some cases a small circle inside a larger one, this symbol like all the others has dozens or hundreds of interpretations and meanings.

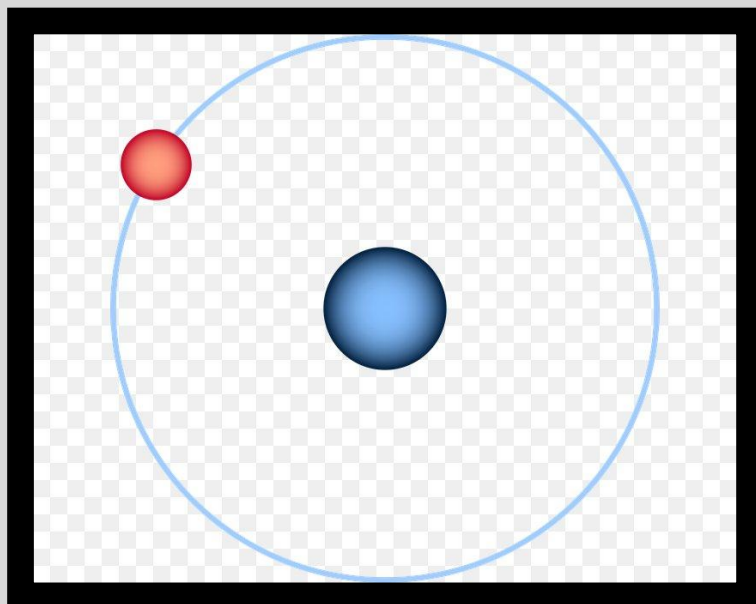
The symbol represents the sun itself, the universe, the principle of existence, the Big Bang, the infinite and so on. This symbol contains the smaller unit in the trigonometry that is the point referred as the **number 1** and the most perfect figure in mathematics, the circle and referred as the **number 0**.



In the Kabbalistic tree of life is the symbol of Kether, the first and highest sephirot from the tree.

In alchemy, each metal has a symbol, the circumpoint represents gold, the most perfect of metals because of its value and beauty.

An interesting fact is that the image resembles a hydrogen atom; our Sun is made up of 73.46% hydrogen.



The **number ten** also can be symbolized by the tenth arcana in Tarot, the **wheel of fortune**.

The **wheel of fortune** represents the winds of changes, destiny, luck, opportunity and winning.



Dear readers, at the end of this experience what I want to prove is that everything arose out of the will of **God**, He created everything according to divine mathematical precepts and all His work is perfect, but the man being manipulated by **Lucifer** uses the sacred doctrines to do evil.
