Linet was more than just his master, always has been. That's why he chose her.

Circling around the belly, their paws met and took hold. A small embrace that meant a tender Thank You. "Thank you, Ari." Or she could just bluntly say it, making him smile brightly along with the charr. "So much. For everything." Looking over the area as the roundness deflated more and more, he could see it in those red eyes; satisfaction. Not only of a job well done, but a

promise of a new life. And if it didn't work this time... Linet would find a way to make it work in the future.
