Born to a human mother and a feline father in Weron, North Triston, Wesley Parry is a semi-human form with feline features. He remembers little of his life in North Triston, as soon after South Triston's brutal United Front was overthrown in July 1993, he and his family moved to Smokestacks, South Triston, when his father Brent earned a position as a civil servant for one of the newly ruling councils, eventually becoming a member of the ruling political party, the South Triston Democracy Party.

Though they reversed the repressive laws that had been put into place by the previous regime, many problems still remained. Namely, many Anthropomorphic creatures openly insulted humans and didn't bother to disguise their contempt for them, even though many of them were also considered victims by the United Front of Triston. Later years saw the party split down the middle by those who wanted to repair the wounds dealt by the previous government, while there were others who wanted revenge against the humans of South Triston.

Several years passed before the feeling of relieved bliss hanging over the country began to diminish, for Wesley's father was later found to be involved in the making of laws that were intended to smother the rights of the country's human citizens. His downfall came when a reporter for The Daily Herald overheard him and another politician talking about serving retribution to the human population. He was quickly sacked from his role amidst virulent protests in Borna City, resulting in him trying anything he could to escape the attention. Ultimately, this never fully abated, even when he was thrown out of his Party in 1998 and stripped of his pension.

Wesley lost his respect for him, believing he was nothing more than a jaded bigot. It was a long time before he began to feel comfortable associating with him again, though his father remained deeply unpopular among the public, with many believing he was largely responsible for the rift that still existed between humans and other species. His mother became a recluse and was almost never seen leaving the house thereafter. Wesley does not talk about his family publicly, as doing so has drawn questions about Brent's turbulent political career.

He moved out in 2007 and rented a top floor flat in the towering Rapa Nui complex in Smokestacks, although by this time, the town had become a very dangerous place, for the conflict between the Cartel and the Yakuza organisations operating in neighbouring towns had escalated into all out war. He managed to find work at a consumer goods warehouse, taking on a night position in its IT department – a job he despised due to disapproving of the way the company was run.

In March 2010, his life was to take a sinister turn, for he met a fellow catgirl named Nancy inside one of the lifts. Though they fell passionately in love, he quickly discovered that she hid a lethal secret that she wanted him to have a part in – she had a dangerous fetish that almost resulted in his demise on their first date. As a result, he kept his distance from her until two months later, but he soon realised, from the teasing messages he received, that she was in fact a serial killer. And despite his attempts to calm her desires, she was able to manipulate him into both turning a blind eye and staying with her, taking advantage of both his adoration for her and, on one occasion, his feline instincts.

Eventually, they both relocated to Burr when he was accepted a job at a night club. While it was not a town he was familiar with, he saw it as a chance to make a new break with his life, and he hoped to be able to calm his girlfriend's desires down. For a period of seven months, his efforts appeared to work, and Nancy did not kill again during this time. However, he remained unaware of just how far her crimes went. And eventually, his efforts were no longer enough.

His family disowned him on the discovery that Nancy had killed his cousin Charles and his father falsely believing that he had known and helped to cover it up. He had to flee for his life once she turned her attention over to him, eventually finding sanctuary in the form of her former friend Sarah, a white dragoness who she had once forced him to attempt to kill.

It was in the aftermath of the much publicised events on the top of the Burr General Hospital's roof that Wesley made the decision to join the police force in the city he had moved to. He felt he could never allow what she had done to be repeated, nor did he feel like he had been doing enough to stop her. The police officer who had interviewed him on each occasion, a well built green and white husky named Superintendent Zoe Banbury, would from then on become who he would answer to.

Much later on, he completed his police training and was determined to do the best he could in the world he lived in now. He quickly developed a skill in dealing with murderers and those suspected of such acts, able to talk them down and on several occasions saving several creatures from them, at one time nearly sacrificing his own life for this end.

During his first few months on the force, he allowed his facial hair to grow out. Some members of the public and even a few fellow officers flirted with him, but he rejected all of them, feeling unable to love again following what Nancy had done. In late 2013, he survived an attempt on his life by the mother of one of her victims, who held him responsible due to missing an opportunity to save her son and his girlfriend. Though he did not hold it against her, he more closely watched his back from then on, always finding a reason to suspect others.

Wesley is easy to get on with when in a pleasant mood, but his determination to bring killers to justice is so strong that he thinks more about his job than what lays outside of it. He has since gone on to find love once more, finding himself unable to resist the niece and cousin of two felines he has become close to, the father and son leopards Terry and Todd Bennett who were an Inspector and Police Constable respectively. He maintains a close bond with his Superintendent, having rescued her brother Travis from Nancy on the night he was fired from his night club job.

On first meeting Linda Adlington, he fell desperately in love with her, with neither able to resist the other. Initially he was reluctant to let her get close, but over time he has allowed her to see more of his sensitive and passionate sides. Though other species no longer scare him, he still retains strong senses of smell and hearing, and can often pick up scents many other species cannot. He is known to have a liking for spirits, in particular vodka. He is regularly seen drinking Blue Tiger vodka, but will accept other drinks if he cannot obtain that brand.

To date, he still lives with Sarah and her boyfriend Wilfred. While he has never been able to let go of the guilt he feels for his actions, Sarah feels there had been no other way to save her and did not hold it against him. Indeed, his job means that he does not spend very long at home, but outside of his job he enjoys board and card games as well as electronic music.
