Roman regards himself to be as ordinary as any immigrant to North Triston was perceived, looked upon as wanting to earn their stripes in a country they hoped to call home upon their emigration from Russia to Serbia in 1991, then to North Triston in 1997. Though he has found it easy to bond with the inhabitants of North Triston, he has sometimes felt like an outsider, a feeling his parents Mirna and Arkady and his older brother Anatoly know only too well.

As a result of where he has lived, both Roman and his brother are trilingual. They can perfectly understand, write and speak Russian, Serbian and English, and though born in Russia, their parents both hail from Serbia and spoke their native language in their household. When Roman speaks in Russian or English, his speech is inflected with a strong Eastern accent many mistake for Russian, his accent being much thicker than Anatoly's. While Anatoly thinks of Russian as his first tongue, Roman considers Serbian his native language and the one he is best at speaking, and he will sometimes subconsciously slip into saying things in this language when speaking either of the other two.

The first thing many notice about him is the patch over his right eye, which he never removes. Just after his 2nd birthday, his parents noticed that his right eye appeared silver instead of red in their photographs and that he was having trouble seeing through that eye. Their doctor instantly referred them to the city's hospital, where a scan revealed that he had developed leukocoria caused by retinoblastoma. Worse, this cancer was an aggressive kind. With no other way to treat it or restore his vision, his right eye was removed and the remaining socket had needed to be eviscerated, the socket being sewn up afterwards.

Being left with only one eye resulted in him lacking any depth perception, hindering what would otherwise have been his natural ability to fly. Other than this, he had seemed as sociable as his parents and his brother had desired him to be. But as time went by, he wasn't slow to pick up on the fact that his missing eye detracted from the perception many creatures had of dragons as being intimidating, and instead saw him as weak. Consequently, he learned how to overcome this by sweet talking and manipulating others when he saw a way to gain something from it.

His years in high school saw him date a string of girlfriends of varying species, although none of these relationships lasted for any longer than a few months. This was something his parents had bemoaned, having desired grandchildren even at their tender ages and fully believing that he and Anatoly would quickly find stable relationships. Roman had suspected that this was due to dragons being very feared in some quarters, but highly desired in some others.

He had difficulty finding members of his own species as a result of not many inhabiting either half of Triston. This was to change when he started a course in IT and business at the Thistlewood College in East Bridgegate, when he found himself seated next to a woman he fell utterly in love with, Nikoleta, who was an immigrant from Rostov on Don, Russia. The two dragons quickly hit it off and were soon spending as much of their available time as they could with each other. Whenever they were separated, Roman found himself believing that half of him was missing.

Unfortunately, his father fiercely disapproved of the relationship. He had formerly worked for the Soviet Union's KGB and had known Nikoleta's father, who had defected to North Triston in 1988. Due to his loyalty to the former regime and his political leanings, as well as its influence on both he and his wife's home countries, he viewed Nikoleta and her family as being wrong for Roman, going so far as to try to sabotage their relationship on several occasions. This only increased the young dragon's desire for her, triggering vicious arguments in their household. Arkady hated either of his sons defying his orders, particularly where relationships were concerned.

Despite Roman and Nikoleta fighting against his grip, he threatened that he would make sure the friends he had in Russia would hunt down and kill her father if he ever caught her coming near his son or any members of his family again.

The very next day, Nikoleta left the college mid term without telling the faculty. The only clue he had was a handwritten note that had been left hanging out of his locker, which simply read, 'For my father's safety, we can't be together, Roman. I'm sorry.' He was fired for his part in

designing their firmware, and after a series of failed odd jobs, joined Anatoly in his company as a firmware designer and tester.

It was during this time that he began developing a fascination with the music industry, and after seeing so many musical acts come and go from Anatoly's business, he started to form a desire a few years into the job to get involved himself. In particular, some of the bands the business sold to were Folk Metal bands, and he soon found himself developing a liking for this genre regardless of where these bands originated from. Some of these bands gave the dragon brothers posters advertising where they would tour, with a few even inviting them to their concerts.
