Summary

Kanade Ogawa (おがわ奏で, *Ogawa Kanade*) is a jonin from the village of Takigakure. She is well known to many in her village as the **Crystal Princess** and also known for her bravery in battle, as well as her shyness outside of battle. She is admired for her kindness and caring nature, and more so for the abilities gifted to her by the Sable of **Ogawa Shrine** (a shrine a few miles outside the village, hidden in a mass of vines and shrubbery) which her clan protects. Her most notable ability is her kekkei genkai, the crystal release. She's able to wield it due to the fact she is related to one of the few members who had lived on her mother's side. She is a descendant from the original clan who possessed this crystal release which flourished many years ago before seemingly going extinct. According to the databook; there are two wielders left; Kanade and Guren.

There are no documents on the clan's name, yet is symbolized by a woman with long black hair, blue eyes, and fair skin, who wears a camellia kimono. No name is given other than the moniker, "Maiden of the Divine Crystal" who looked to be of royal lineage, yet looked very poor and seemingly mistreated upon reading into her expression.

Background

Kanade was born into a small family of a mother and two older brothers; her father left her mother months after she was born. She grew up inside and was told to study special jutsu from her mother who was the Ogawa Shrine keeper before her. She assumed her duties as the new keeper, and developed her crystal release by the guidance of the wise old .

Upon becoming a genin, she had already delved into her spiritual studies. By this time, she had reached almost halfway to the potential she'd possess in the future, and was given the family heirloom - The Flute of the Shrine Maiden. This flute allows her to summon the old fox and his underlings in order to give her their assistance in battle. She became known for her ninjutsu prowess and calmness in battle, as well as the tactical skills she was taught over the years.

Personality

Kanade grew up having a very calm personality, though her face always seemed to show more emotion than she seemed capable of. Even upon turning 16, Kanade doesn't appear to be out of contact with others' emotions as much as she actually is. It is difficult to understand what she is thinking most of the time due to her inability to speak her mind or express acryal emotion. Her lack of acknowledging expression also makes it difficult to know if she has any consciousness. As the series progresses, she actually shows a bit of worry for her teammates, and depression upon losing her second oldest brother.

She actually was unaware she even had a friendship with her own teammates, until they protected her on their 5th mission and told her so upon teaming up to save her from being kidnapped. Although this did not change her personality all that much, she insisted they give her a nickname if they so choose to become closer. They were accepting of this and often refer to her as "Eihime" meaning "crystal princess".

Later on, she opens up to a young man her age she developed feelings for. She revealed to actually have some what of a tsundere attitude with him; pouty, flustered, snarky, and annoyed on the outside while truly being shy about her true emotions. After spending more time with her, the boy discovers more of her personality and her startling lack of common sense. He quite often calls her "Ten-chan" referring to her connection to japanese sables ir martens. She seems to have a large amount of pain tolerance, as she has been stabbed and fatally wounded several

times by enemies, including Sasuke, without any reaction or indication of suffering and often feels indifferent to sympathy and shows none of most occasions, while being open to empathy.

Appearance

Kanade is fair skinned, has noticeable pink lips with black eyeliner around her emerald green eyes, and usually wears a worried or concerned facial expression. She has emerald green eyes, followed by a very baby like face; she wears her long, silvery hair tied to the right side over her shoulder, with a black hair band accented with a silver plate.

Kanade's outfit consists of a red Shrine Maiden's coat with a strap over the very top, split down the middle to each side, consisting of long sleeves that allow her to high her handsigns, and bows tied to the bottom corners of the fabric. She wears a black dress, assumably low chested, which ends 2 or 3 inches above her knees, with greyish fur lining the bottom; her boots are also black, thigh highed, not open toed, with grey fur lining the top. Lastly, she wears a semi loose green obi around her waist, with her village's hitai-ate plate at the top of said obi, with the Takigakure symbol.

Abilities

Chakra and Physical Prowess

Kanade has over average chakra reserves, but they are not large. She is well tuned into her spiritual aspects as well as her physical, and has exceptional abilities over all because of this; she is, however, low in speed, but actually has decent stamina. She utilizes water release, and her most notable abilities lie within her Flute of the Shrine Maiden which is used to communicate with summon animals she has a contract with, mainly the wise old fox from Ogawa Shrine; this includes him minions. She has a high intellect from the fox's teachings, as well as a wide range of ninjutsu. She has a weakness to her elements' natural opposites, and a major weakness to lightning based attacks. Lastly, she has excellent hearing and smelling capabilities; another aspect taught to her by the fox. Kanade's biggest weaknesses are her lack of speed and taijutsu, as well as her crystal release has a disadvantage to sound, lightning, fire, and wind techniques.

Crystal Release

Kanade is able to utilize crystal release in the same way Guren does. She can seemingly crystallize anything and even the moisture in the air itself, though she often doesn't show off her power unless she needs to.

Her most notable technique is her Crystal Shrine jutsu that traps her inside a crystal shrine in order to protect her while she wields her spiritual sound based jutsu. The crystal is also exceedingly strong, only being able to be destroyed from the inside when a barrier is created using it.

Her crystal release does, however, have a weakness to sound, lightning, fire, and wind - shattering upon contact with jutsu of these natures. She can overcome water, earth, and wood - all are useless against her crystal..

Water Release

Kanade utilizes water release as her secondary element. She can use it as well due to her village's teaching, as well as utilizes it alongside Crystal Release in two specific jutsu.

Kanade carries water in a large bottle-like container for emergency use, but mainly utilizes it from natural sources.

- She is often clumsy around people she likes and has a Tsundere disposition for her crush.
- She likes flowers, gemstones, sables, and expensive jewelry; She dislikes snakes, ramen, and natto paste.
- The old Sable of Ogawa Shrine is given a name by Kanade, her naming him Master Tenchi-sama which she describes as meaning "ten" for the Japanese Marten, "chi" for eternal, and "sama" for master. She calls him Master Tenchi in the english dub.
- While she does guard a shrine, she is believed to either be a shintoist, or having no religion what-so-ever.
