Design: Tibetian Fox, heavy set, antenna upon head.

Lore:

How Lane came to be is unknown. A disappeared around his time, though few make any connections. What is known is that this robot is just as closely intrigued by the kitchen as some chefs and has a position there. It often speaks with kind and sweet words, but can sometimes go haywire and become jealous and 'bratty' at times. Despite that, Lane is an amazing addition to the Fazbear Family, as many children find comfort in hugging his big warm belly. There are mild concerns he's promoting obesity, but these are to be dismissed on sight.

Murder Protocol:

Lane isn't overly aggressive and appears to kill only to satisfy its hunger. Not that it eats his victims, but its obvious that he becomes sated after (attempting) to kill.

Each night, either he or Chice procures a large cake, which he begins to consume. Upon full consumption, whatever side he ate last determines which hall he goes down. He moved quickly, but he betrays his timing by a loud burp and heavy, but muffled stomping. He bumps into the door, seemingly unwilling to acknowledge it. Once it made an attempt, it retreats to the kitchen.

During rowdier times, it is known to eat and attack multiple times, with his eating speed varying.

Trivia:

- Loves poutine and appears to make it despite it not being on the menu.
- Strangely disinterested in skinnier kids, possibly to promote purchase of food.
- Is known to react very erratically at times.
- Consumes food despite not requiring it. Often dirty but smells 'delicious'.
- Is known to get too involved with feet, do not put near the ballpen.

Zyla the Zipfox

OR

Fastfeet the Fox

Real Name: Closest estimate is "Zyla Garthori".

Age: Unknown.

Theme: Tribal / Indian. **Height:** 160~170cm

Gender: F

Position: Hide & Seek machine, moonlights as seductress at the Lazy Lounge.

Special Attributes: Tribal clothing and make up. **Design:** Regular fox with green and black accents.

Lore:

A sneaky snooper went astray and ended up getting Foxified. She seemed to seduce Foxy for a time, according to footage, before seeming to change as she did so. It is believed that her transformation kicked in shortly after landing in Foxy's arms, and that she was 'reviving' during her dance. Due to her innate light frame and movement, she is assigned to entertain kids during the day and work at the Lazy Lounge at night.

Murder Protocol:

It is hard to foresee her motions. Zyla appears to respond negatively to light, and only moves if the light have been left off for a period of time. This accounts for BOTH hallways. If her eyes glow, she will not move, but when they turn off, BOTH lights must be turned on to scare her off. If she moves, she arrives as quickly as foxy (a little later on the right door), and will stay until the lights move. If the door is open, a kill is guaranteed.

Essentially, Foxy, but with lights and harder to see coming.

Trivia:

- Is an intruder, with the management claiming she was a 'surprise purchase'.
- Her tribal design was primarily due to her strange coloration.
- Functions as an alternative to Foxy in her regular mode.
- Has multiple problems with her image because she 'insults' native people.

Toby the Tending Tiger

OR

Tony the Technician

Age: Unknown. **Theme:** Alternative? **Height:** 180~190 cm

Gender: M

Position: Maintains the CCTV and other electronics, moonlights as bartender at the Lazy Lounge.

Special Attributes: An entire wardrobe, toolkit. **Design:** Tiger with rubbery, alternative clothing.

Lore:

This one came out of nowhere. Camera footage is blurry and shows him getting knocked out by a shock in the kitchen, before being taken to the parts room for 'modifications'. While the animatronics were gone, the lights failed. Upon repair, this robotic tiger was found. Due to his means of creation, he is very focussed on his job, as if stuck in a mental limbo.

During the day, he mostly sticks to himself, trying to avoid social contact.

Murder Protocol:

Due to his strange means of acquisition, this tiger has no murder protocol, and is uncaring about the death or survival of anyone within FNAF. This leads some to believe he transformed out of his own will, to never get involved with the other animatronics.

Instead, it appears to move from camera to camera at night, maintaining them. He often obstructs view and sometimes disables cameras. When these camera go back online, they have enhanced night vision until another animatronic knocks it off again.

He normally passes through the office without paying mind, but is known to creepily observe. When locked out, he politely knocks twice, and then seeks an alternative route. If the door or light buttons are broken and he is in the room, he will fix them, giving you time to defend yourself.

On later nights, he is known to steal the monitor for a few seconds, before giving it back. Perhaps it tries to assess its current status. During this, other animatronics can still attack.

On earlier nights, he only obstructs/repairs cameras once. Once all have been checked, he goes to a blind spot and remains invisible for the night. On later nights, odds of upgrades to cameras are lower, and time of obstruction are longer. It is unknown why this varies, but it might be that he **just recently fixed them**.

Trivia:

- Refuses to fix the kitchen camera, potentially due to it being the one that stunned him.
- Changes movement speed randomly.
- Doesn't obstruct the Pirate Cove cameras AS MUCH, likely to avoid pissing off the one inside. The PC camera is also never upgraded.
- Seems reluctant to go on stage as well, likely to avoid the animatronics there.
